

- As the crowd has grown, so have the expenses. It costs far more to serve a Shabbos meal to 120-180 students in 2006, than it cost to serve 25-30 students in 1997. Attendance at all our events has increased, and so have the costs. In addition, due to increased need, new services are provided, adding to the cost.
